

Quantum Industry Board (QIB) – Rules of Procedure

Composition and task of the QIB

The QIB is a forum for information transfer and discussion. It is part of the project OpenQKD and will be managed by the project coordinator. It is open for companies, stakeholders, or other interest groups that are interested in getting information at first hand related to the objectives/results of the project and in discussing those information with others.

Information flow

Nature of the information given to the QIB

All information given to the QIB – presentation, hand-out, news via the mailing list – will be regarded as ‘project publication’. The QIB is set up as part of the dissemination activities of the project.

QIB-Mailing list

All interested parties can register to the QIB-mailing list and will periodically receive information about project status and news items and general updates concerning quantum communication. To register send a mail to bob@opengkd.eu with the text “QIB subscription” in the subject line. Please include your full name, the name of your institution and your position there.

The name and the institution of all members of the QIB-mailing list are visible to all other members and OpenQKD project partners in order to facilitate free and open discussions.

QIB-Meetings

Within the framework of other project meetings a dedicated session will be offered (e.g. at the day following a project plenary) where information will be presented. Such a session will be announced via the project web-site or via the mailing-list (see below). People that plan to attend have to register.

Rights and obligations of the QIB participants

Prior to each QIB-meeting the mailing list members will have to register to the event. In this registration their rights and obligations as well as data protection regulations will be needed to be agreed by the potential QIB-meeting members. All information disclosed during a meeting will be accessible to the QIB members with the rights to share the received information but with the obligation to uphold the copyright notices thereof. Furthermore the members attending a QIB meeting will be made aware that all information shared by them during such a meeting is not covered by a confidential obligation and can be used and shared freely.

Financial provisions

The project bears the costs for QIB-sessions (renting a conference room, offering of refreshment). The participants have to bear the travel costs and accommodation costs (i.e. hotels, meals) by themselves.
